It is with great excitement that I write to you and tell you we are planning on a near normal summer after the year of crazy issues we had last year. We had only 500 campers last summer and we were the only Christian Camp in the state of Ohio that operated as close to normal as possible! We had 22 baptisms and we praise God for the opportunities to share the love of Christ last summer. This year things seem to be moving toward a more normal camp season and we already have more than a thousand campers ready to be here!!!

As it is every year we operate with a 'no camper turned away policy'. This means that if anyone needs financial assistance in sending their son or daughter to camp we will offer scholarships. This typically results in a \$15,000 – \$20,000 need. God has always provided in these cases. We are asking you or any of your friends, small groups or Sunday School classes to participate in our scholarship drive. We are looking for \$250 which covers the total cost of sending a kid to camp.
