

Dear Campers and Families,

Horse Camp 1 is just a few weeks away, and I bet that your child is as excited as we are for what that week will bring! We have a wonderful faculty who are praying for your children and that God will use us to bless and guide them.

Our theme is BULLETPROOF with the corresponding theme song by Citizen Way. We will focus on putting on the Armor of God as described in Ephesians 6:10-18. I encourage campers to memorize this passage in preparation for learning how to use it in their lives.

Check the camp website for a complete packing list, but here are some particulars for this week:

Hat, Rain Jacket and water bottle with name on it; Sunscreen and Insect Repellent.

Jeans or riding pants for each day. Leggings and nylon athletic pants are **not** riding pants. Jeans/pants should not be too tight or too loose, and should cover undergarments when bending over. Shirts that cover the shoulder must be worn while riding. Boots with appropriate socks are essential.

No dangling earrings or long artificial nails. Any piercings other than ears must be removed for safety.

Bring a bath towel + a swimming towel + a face towel and washcloth, soap, shampoo and deodorant. Leave the hand sanitizer and perfume sprays at home.

We want to enjoy God's creation, the horses, and each other without the disruption of electronics, so *leave phones, I-Pods, tablets, and alarm clocks at home. Campers may bring a Camera to take pictures.

Horse Camp is different than any other camp. We have 18 Campers ranging in age from 10 to 16 years, of varying sizes and riding levels. There will be 9 horses/ponies and three groups of riders. We strive to coordinate the best fit of horse and rider, so we ask that campers come with positive and accepting attitudes. We will show the same towards each camper.

Please complete the enclosed waiver, with camper and parents' signatures (preferably both parents) and bring it with you on Sunday, June 23rd. You will come to Registration beginning at 4:00pm. The faculty and I look forward to meeting you and spending a week of fun, challenge and growth with you as we put on God's armor and become Bulletproof!
